WORLD RUGBY LEVEL 2 PRACTICAL ASSESSMENT

World Rugby requires that every coach who has done the World Rugby Level 2 course be practically assessed to qualify as a Level 2 coach.

In Mpumalanga, there are coaches who have done the World Rugby Level 2 Course but have not yet been assessed practically. If you as a coach are not assessed practically, you do not qualify as a World Rugby Level 2 coach.

Coaches who have done the World Rugby Level 2 course from 2018 to date that have not been assessed are invited to a practical assessment session.

Coaches who have not been practically assessed in September 2022 get one last opportunity to be practically assessed. If you as a coach are not assessed practically on 13-14 January 2023, you must re-do the entire Level 2 course at your own expense.

See Transcript attached to which you will be assessed.

You should also bring your Diary of coaching sessions and completed matches.

Schools and clubs will have to pay the full price for the number of coaches registered e.g. three coaches registered but only two attend the practical assessment, payment for all three still required. Expenses (booking of facilities and meals) are incurred after entry forms have been received.

WHAT MUST COACHES BRING WITH?

Notebook and pen

Dress in suitable sport clothing as per expected weather for practical.

Health check as per Rugby Ready guidelines

A team will be provided and you will be assessed practically. Rugby equipment will be provided.

- Bring diary of coaching sessions and completed matches.
- Coaches must present their Coaching portfolio and Diary to the facilitator Mr Hennie van Vuuren before the practical session.
- Coaches must ensure that their on-lines are up-to-date before the assessment. **Face – 2 face courses Coaching L2 15s**
- A team from the Puma Rugby Institute will be provided for practical assessment.
- Rugby equipment will be provided.

- Coaches can check the Level 2 transcript on World Rugby for which the Assessor will assess your practical.

By January 2023 all coaches within the borders of the Mpumalanga Rugby Union, MUST have a valid coaching licence - World Rugby Qualification Level 1 or they will not be allowed to coach within the borders of Mpumalanga (as per BokSmart Ruling). This ruling is in the final stages of being legislated by government. Total compliance by all parties concerned is expected.

Coaches who have done World Rugby Level 1 must complete a full rugby season before he/she can attend the World Rugby Level 2 Course.

WORLD RUGBY LEVEL 2 ACCREDITATION

Issuing of World Rugby Coaching Level 2 Certificate:

Coaches that have completed the World Rugby Level 2 Coaches Course must adhere to the following criteria:

- Coach for one season
- Team must play matches
- Complete the Logbook/Coaches Diary for all coaching sessions and completed matches:
 - Coach's Personal Information
 - Player information
 - Player attendance
- **Team Management Checklist:**
 - A. Pre-Season
 - B. During Season
 - C. Before, During and After the Game
 - D. After the Season
 - E. Conclusion

It is the responsibility of the coach to communicate with an educator/assessor on completion of the season to organise a practical assessment, date and venue.

The educator will attend the practical session and complete **Transcript for Accreditation as a World Rugby Level 2 Coach**, check the Diary that the coach had to complete for practices and matches.

The competency of the coach will be indicated on the form. The educator sends the Transcript to World Rugby in Ireland where after a certificate will be issued to coaches.

Coaches that completed the World Rugby Level 2 Course in 2018 will have to coach, be assessed and rated competent during the 2022 season to qualify as a World Rugby Level 2 Coach.
